[JOSIE KIM]20s – 30s, Korean-American, is Andrew's smart, capable, and hard-charging wife. Josie has never failed at anything in her life. The mother of two young children, Josie is desperate to give them the kind of small-town upbringing she enjoyed. She moves her family back to Missouri and does everything she can to keep the peace between her husband and her father, as well as reining in Andrew's demanding grandmother Barbara....SERIES REGULAR

[ANDREW DENTON]20s – 30s, a likeable nerd, is Josie's husband. He prides himself on being a progressive, enlightened, modern man. A lawyer by trade, he has become increasingly disillusioned with his life in Los Angeles and makes the difficult decision to move his family to his wife's hometown of St. Christopher, Missouri. There he must contend with his father-in-law Jae, a charismatic and bull-headed Tae Kwon Do grandmaster who has not yet fully accepted Andrew....SERIES REGULAR

[JAE KIM]50s, Korean, is Josie's father and the charismatic, strong-willed, demanding owner of Kim's Academy, a successful Tae Kwon Do studio in St. Christopher. Jae moved to Missouri in 1972 and soon established his highly successful martial arts business. Jae is beloved and respected by his students. The classic immigrant success story and a devoted family man, Jae has not yet fully accepted Andrew, who he feels is not quite worthy of his daughter....SERIES REGULAR

[SUN KIM]50s, Korean, is Josie's mom and Jae's Wife. Although Sun has lived in the United States for thirty years, she still holds on to many traditional Korean values, a characteristic which sometimes frustrates her more progressive daughter. Sun is by nature a little reserved, and has a tendency to withhold love, though she cares for her family very much...SERIES REGULAR

[GARY FARGER]20s – 30s, is Jae's sycophantic chief instructor at Kim's Academy. Gary's been taking Tae Kwon Do lessons from Jae his whole life, and looks up to him as a father, and perhaps as a god. Gary will do anything that Jae requires, including cutting his hair and mowing his lawn.
